What is Remote Learning?

Remote Learning is using electronic technologies to access educational curriculum outside of a traditional classroom.

Instructional Delivery

All elementary and middle school classes will be utilizing Google Suite as our classroom learning space. Some of our high school teachers will be using PowerSchool Learning Classrooms as they have been all year.

Google Classroom

Our Google Classroom is where you will find weekly lessons, assignments, and a variety of resources to support Remote Learning. Students will submit assignments for teacher feedback. Grades will be taken for assigned work. This [Parents' Guide to Google Classroom](#) may help you.

Google Hangout Meet

Google Hangout is a communication platform that can be used for video conferencing, class meetings, chat, and collaboration. Teachers will share a join link on their google classroom, share a class code, or share a calendar invite with the link. Remind your children to **dress appropriately** when participating in video conferencing/Google Hangout Meet. Their entire class will see them and their surroundings.

How do I support Remote Learning?
