## Earl Bradsher Preschool Events Calendar

The smell of spring is in the air. The trees are ready to blossom and you're getting anxious to enjoy the outdoors without that big and bulky coat.

There are many fun things to do as a family when spring weather arrives. Here are some ideas:

Try some of these fun outdoor games with your family & friends.

**Shoe-Pile Scramble:** Talk about a challenge for kids! Pile shoes in the yard. Kids run from the starting line, find their shoes and put them on -- fast!

**Stepping Stones:** Cross an imaginary stream in a race that requires both skill and speed. Each player gets two stepping stones—an old t-shirt, hand towel or dish cloth. Each player races to the finish line by standing on one stone, placing the second one ahead of him, then jumping on that stone without touching the grass. Then he reaches behind him to retrieve the first stone and places it ahead of him, and so on. First one to reach the finish line wins!

**Bubble Brigade:** You'll need a starting line, a designated turnaround point, and two teams (with at least two players per team). Also, bubble solution and a wand for each player. Each team lines up, shoulder-to-shoulder. The first person on each team blows a bubble and catches it on her wand. She then passes it to the next player, who passes it to the next, and so on. If the bubble pops, the person passing it must blow another bubble and then pass it on. The first team to get a bubble to the end of its line wins.

**Bossy Ball:** You will need a playground ball, masking tape, and a permanent marker for this game. First, randomly stick 7 to 12 strips of tape on the ball. Use a permanent marker to write rules for throwing and catching the ball: "overhead and backwards," "underhand, between the legs," "sitting down," "standing on one leg," "eyes closed," "in mid air," "while singing," or any other you can think of. The game is played like any other game of catch, but once the first player grabs the ball, she must look at the words under or closest to the palm on her right hand. She has to throw this ball as the directed by the words—and the second player has to catch it in the same manner. The second player then looks at the words under his palm of his right hand, and so on.
